We hope that if you haven't submitted a pledge card yet, you will do so today!

Our desire is to erase our indebtedness over the next two years in order to make more resources available for ministry.

Candidly, we have had a large number of our older members retire and move away in recent years, and, as is usually the case, these are the folks who have been committed to and supporting the ministry here for several decades. Without their tithes, our revenue has fallen, and we are finding it difficult to both fund the staff and ministries we have, as well as manage the large monthly mortgage payments.

Your help is crucial to the mission! Our current monthly budget calls for an income of \$9,000 a week, and you can track how we are doing weekly in the bulletin. That \$9,000 includes the regular amount we are paying on our mortgage, but does not include the extra we have been pledging to retire the debt.

If we can pay off our debt in two years, we will have available resources to expand our present ministry into our community as God calls us, and we will be able to care for the needs of our staff and facility.

You may have been thinking, paying off the mortgage is a nice goal, but it isn't a necessity. Well, actually, it is. The only other option we may have is to refinance our debt and stretch out the payments. This would be a huge step backwards, in that it would be expensive to refinance, and we would be saddled with additional debt for a longer period of time.

We hope you will join us on this mission. The programs that MCN offers to the community, from Cornerstone Christian School to Celebrate Recovery, from Children's Musicals to Youth Group, from Sunday School to Senior lunches, all are vital to our mission here in Manchester. We need your support and we trust that as you help us deliver this ministry to our neighborhood, we will see God move in mighty ways.
