
Every Other Sunday!

Holy Week Services

- Maundy Thursday Service (3/28) at 7:00PM at The Salvation Army Church. This is a traditional service based on the actions of Jesus at the Last Supper, specifically, the foot washing, and the new commandment given . . . that we love one another and follow Jesus' example of service.
- Tenebrae Service (3/29) at 7:00PM at MCN. "Tenebrae" is the Latin word meaning "darkness." The story of the suffering and death of Jesus is told through scripture reading accompanied by increasing darkness. The service concludes with a loud sound followed by silence as we are left to consider the impact of Christ's sacrifice and await His coming resurrection.
- Early Easter Morning (3/31) at Center Memorial Park/ Downtown Manchester at 7:00AM. Join several other churches and the full Salvation Army Orchestra at the park next to the library downtown. Sing out the good news that Jesus is alive! Breakfast follows at the Salvation Army church across the street
